

EROSION CAUSED BY SOLAR PROJECTS



In the photo above, The Attorney General sued the developer for violations of the Federal Clean Water Act, the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act and the Massachusetts Clean Waters Act

The local zoning board and state had no knowledge of this problem, until a local resident attended a county meeting and showed the local officials these images.

* The (DOJ) and the (EPA) announced settlements with solar farm owners to resolve violations of the Clean Water Act in states from Alabama into the central corn belt and up to Idaho.

*The Maine Board of Environmental Protection and Office of the Attorney General along with the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality fined multiple solar developments for violating state erosion and sedimentation regulations.

*In Georgia, \$135.5 million was awarded to a family after a solar developer cleared 1,000 acres of timber and farmland allowing silt and sediment to turn a fishing lake into a mud hole.

*The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality found degradation of the floodplain and wetlands from a solar development onto surrounding properties and decreased water quality into waters downstream.

FIRES INVOLVING SOLAR PANELS



Solar Panels Have a History of Starting Fires.

*Walmart had 7 of their stores catch on fire, due to faulty solar panels.

*A bird on a wire, started a fire that burned a 1,127 acre solar project.

*Solar components from multiple companies have been recalled due to starting fires.

*Volunteer Fire Departments REFUSE to go into Commercial Solar Projects to fight a fire, due to safety concerns for the firefighters.

*San Francisco refuses to allow firefighters fight a solar fire, without special breathing equipment, due to the Cancer Causing Toxic Chemicals in the Smoke.

***Even a PRO-Solar Magazine states, “As heat degrades solar panels during a fire, they generate toxic air pollution. When a fire melts these elements, they create health-hazardous smoke. “**

TAXATION WITHOUT REPRESENTATION



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* The Town of Grandview, Indiana approved the construction of a Commercial Solar Project to be built on 37 parcels of local farmland.

* 36 of those parcels are located OUTSIDE the Grandview Corporate Limits, in the county.

* Therefore Grandview NEVER had the legal authority to approve ANY type of construction on 36 of those parcels.

* But the offer of \$650,000 in cash from the solar developer, was too much of an enticement for a majority of the Grandview Town Board and ALL of the Grandview Zoning Board Members to turn down.

* When the Spencer County Commissioners were asked to help stand up for the rights of the tax payers living outside the Town of Grandview, NONE OF THEM were willing to enforce their own zoning regulations and protect their taxpayers.

* Therefore, 79 local residents, living within 3 miles of the proposed solar project, have filed a lawsuit in an attempt to stop this injustice.

Farm Drainage Tiles Destroyed by Solar Panels



- * Two Years after a Solar Farm was built, neighbors discovered flooded basements and other damage caused by Drainage Tiles under the Solar Project had been destroyed by the installation of the posts used to hold the solar panels.
- * Contractors tried to repair the damage by forcing tons of DRY concrete powder underground.
- * Neighbors complain about flooded basements
- *Some Neighboring Farmers Complain about Roads being flooded or even washed out plus basements being flooded for the first time in 50 years,
- *Other neighbors complain about Wells and Ponds becoming DRY, due to changing the flow of water after drainage tiles were destroyed, during the construction of the solar projects.
- * A farmer or his family will NOT be able to reclaim this property for farming again, in 25 to 30 years without reinstalling new drainage tiles and breaking up tons of concrete in unknown depths?
